Experience a walk back in time to the 1880's as you tour historic Pullman, its community, and the Pullman Administration Building National Monument.

Meet at 11am to visit the Historic Pullman Foundation Exhibit Hall, located at 11141 S. Cottage Gove Ave, Chicago, IL 60628.

After a 20-minute video on Pullman and the town, and exploring the Exhibit Hall, your docent will take you on a short guided walking tour of the town. You'll receive informed commentary about the history of Pullman, its architecture, and the landmark historic community today. Your guide will also be available to answer any questions your group may have.

You will have the opportunity to visit the historic Administration Building of The National Park Service Pullman National Monument. Pullman National Monument was designated by President Barack Obama on February 19, 2015, making it the first National Park Service unit in Chicago. The park tells the story of one of the first planned industrial communities in the United States, the sleeping car magnate who helped create it, and the workers who lived there. The district is significant for its influence on urban planning and design, as well as its role in American labor history, including the 1894 Pullman Strike and Boycott.

How to get there

By car from the north: Take the Dan Ryan. Exit at the 111th St Exit #66A and go west on 111th Street. Turn right into the Visitor Center parking lot (after the 3rd light, after the Rocktenn sign).

From the South: Follow I-94 West toward Chicago. Exit at the 111th street exit #66A. Go west on 111th Street and then turn right into the Visitor Center parking lot (after the 3rd light, after the Rocktenn sign).

CTA (Chicago Transit Authority) City Bus Route #111-Pullman: Route #115 runs along Cottage Grove Avenue and stops at 11000 S. Cottage Grove, right across from the Administration-Clock Tower Visitor Center.

Metra: take the Electric Line from Millennium Station or any other stop along the line. There is a train that departs Millennium Station at 10:10 am and arrives at the 111th St Stop (Pullman) at 10:41am. After arriving at the station, walk through the station house and down the stairs. Walk east (right turn) to Cottage Grove Avenue. Cross to the park and walk South along Cottage Grove towards 112th St and the Pullman
